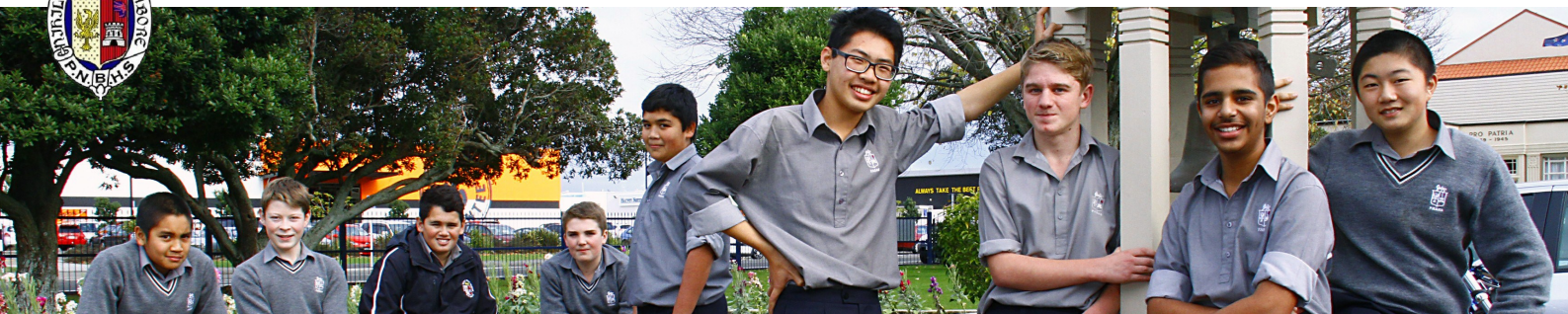
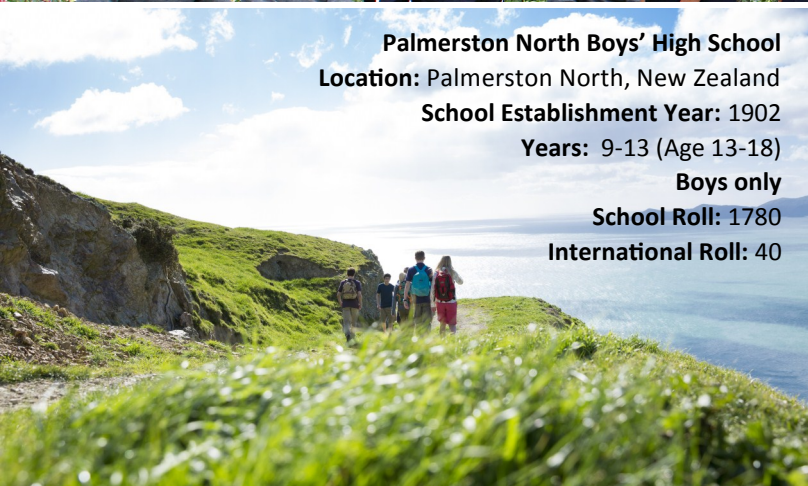

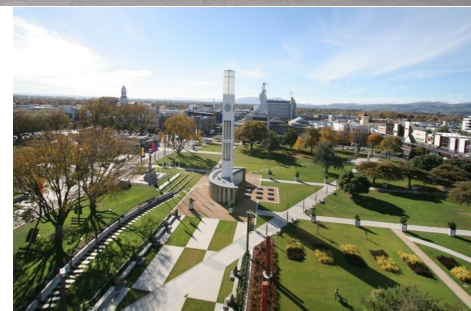


NEW ZEALAND
