A Typical Weekday of a Boarder at College House

Time	Activity
6:45am	Boarders wake-up. A hostel run may be scheduled. Boarders shower and clean dorm.
7.30 – 8.00am	Breakfast. Pack morning tea to take to school.
8.20am	Dormitory inspection.
8.35am	Depart for school.
1.20pm	Boarders return to College House for lunch. Boarders depart from Dining Room for school once they have finished lunch.
3.20pm	Return to College House from school.
3.20 – 5.25pm	Sports training or co-curricular activities. Town leave may be taken on the following days:

Year 9 and 10 – Monday
Year 11 – Monday/Wednesday
Year 12 and 13 – No set days

5.30 – 6.15pm	Dinner. All boarders remain in Dining Hall for presentations and notices.
6.15 – 7.15pm	Free time. Marching practice or other College House activities may be completed in this time.
7.30 – 9.00pm	Prep (study). Year 9 – 11: Supervised prep in classrooms at school Year 12: Supervised prep in Year 12 prep room at College House Year 13: Independent study in own rooms
9.15pm	Year 9 and 10 “lights out”
9.30pm	Year 11 “lights out”
10.00pm	Year 12 “lights out”
